Where are you from?

Krosno, home of glass blowing in Poland. My family moved to Chicago in 1992, winning the Bill Clinton Greencard lottery. Our Collection is now carried at the Saks Fifth Avenue on Michigan Ave in Chicago...now my family from Krosno has more reason to come visit.

How'd you get into fashion?

My European sensibility and diverse Chicago community spirited my interest in technically based, visual creativity.

Has it been a hard industry to break?
